## STUDENT TESTIMONY

Deb - I am 45 years old and from West Virginia. I was raised in a great family. I knew of and believed in the Lord, but I didn't have a personal relationship with Him. At the age of 18, I started rebelling. I was full of pride and spent many years drinking and caring about no one but myself. At the age of 35, my marriage of 10 years ended. I was devastated. Instead of turning to the Lord, I turned to drugs. I was prescribed Tylox, Percosets and eventually Oxycontin. Of course, I abused these drugs. When I didn't get high from eating or snorting them, I started doing drugs by IV. I would lie, cheat, rob, steal and do anything to get more. My health deteriorated. I had grand mal seizures and was on two blood pressure pills a day. I had abscesses in both arms. But, all this did not make me quit. I continued to abuse drugs trying to fill the void and pain in my heart.

By God's grace I was arrested for selling drugs. While incarcerated, I gave my heart to Jesus. When I was released, I walked the Christian life for over a year. I had a job and was happier than I had ever been. But struggles came into the home. My younger brother went to prison on drug charges, and my older brother took his own life, also due to addiction. Through all the pain, I once again started compromising and fell harder than ever. Again I was arrested. I had failed my family, the court system, myself, and most of all God. I had even planned a way to end my life. But once more I cried out to the Lord, and once again He heard my cry. He worked through my probation officer and the judge, and I was sent to Teen Challenge. Today, I know that Jesus is all I need. My Lord has healed me.



He has given me a peace and joy that floods my soul. He comforts me and fills that void in my heart. He has also healed my body. I am no longer on high blood pressure medication, antidepressants or nerve pills. Isaiah 40:31, "For they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength, they shall mount up with wings as eagles. They shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint."

When doubts and fears assail and the storms of life are raging, look away to Jesus. He is a friend that sticketh closer than a brother. He will never leave you nor forsake you. As He stilled the raging storm at sea when His disciples were perplexed, He is going to still the storm in your life. He said, "Be still and know that I am God." We stand in faith with you. Only believe!
